

For that purpose, organizing training programmes, workshops, Seminars, Conferences, in area of Applied Psychology involving other branches of Psychology would be very fruitful. Create some placement opportunity, Capacity building programmes in the area of Psychology for Dalit students, businessman, School teachers, parents, and community could be an added benefit. According to Census (2011), 27.5% of the total population of India is Youth. According to the National Youth Policy (2014), their age is 15-29 years. Normally, the Youth is defined as the people who are at age of 15-29 years. The total population of Bihar is 1,040, 99 452, about 26.9% of the total population is youth. As the poor state like Bihar, educational status of the youth is quite bad in higher education as like other states of India. The health status of youth is also lacking because of poverty. They have lack of money. 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counsellor for guide Dalit youths, class struggle, family struggle, personal struggle, mental stress, lack of right technical academic institutions, lack of proper training for lab by teachers, lack of suitable lab, lack of a modern library, lack of appropriate syllabus, moral degradation, consumption of alcohol by youth, early maturity, violence in colleges, materialism, obesity, educational diversity, lack of education, childhood crime, lack of political interest, increasing unemployment, lack of health facilities, lack of inadequate opportunity, corruption, terrorism, lack of development of industries, etc. Apart from these, there may be some other reasons. The Dalit youths has been wandering from the right path. So, Psychology may be playing an important role to solve all these problems. For, these collective efforts are needed, by the government, society, parents, teachers, youth and psychologists have an important role; the government will also have to provide all the facilities, which is important for us? Parents, youth and teacher will also have to follow their duties. Hence, Psychology will be fruitful to re-orient the Dalit youth of Bihar and contribute to the development of their state. #### Major Evils of Dalit youths

Some applied branches psychology like clinical psychology, counseling psychology, guidance psychology, organizational Psychology, and industrial psychology is teaching in Bihar for only academic purposes. The Dalit youths of Bihar does not aware its application for employment purpose.

There is no any well psychological laboratory in the different university of Bihar. The curriculum of psychology does not latest according to the latest need of employment. Rarely, Teacher has interested to teach these new branches of psychology. The state government has not interested to improve higher education for employment purposes because of political purposes. So, how can it possible to re-orient the Dalit youths of Bihar?

## Limitation of Psychology

Some psychologists, such as Durganand Sinha, has also told the limited scope of psychology because it is not a policy science; there is a lack of proper data, so that, for policy purpose there is need suitable data. Then, Implement the right policy for the Dalit youths. Future Bright of India depends upon several factors, Psychologist have been debating since inception the Role of Psychology in the nation building. Prof. Jai B P Sinha argues strongly in the favor of Pivotal role of Psychology in defining the development, identifying its indicators, Designing social institutions, and relationships, and planning strategy for national development. In contrast, Mehtar (1984) feels that psychology is too young and too weak to cope with the problems of development:

"... The idea of national development is enormously complex and it is unrealistic to expect a nascent science like psychology to have affected the course of national development."

### CONCLUSIONS

There is need common education system for all over the country, common health facilities of all, the eradication of caste system, the abolition of dowry system, the appropriate environment for all, the basic facilities to everyone, Social justice for all etc. It is also an important aspect for the nation development. Despite of all, it is necessary for re-orient the Dalit youths of Bihar to aware all the practical aspects of different branches of applied branches of psychology. We are discussing about some technique and theories which are very important for enhance the employment in the area of applied psychology. Clinical psychologist must know all these technique like clinical assessment tool like MMPI, Rorschach test, Aptitude test, Attitude test, Vocational interest test etc., psychobiological exploration of mental illness, several psychotherapies, and clinical pharmacopsychology. Clinical psychologist is diagnosing and treating more common disorders like learning disabilities, substance abuse, depression, anxiety, and eating disorders. Counselling and Guidance psychologist must know the experience the different areas like pre-college guidance, educational guidance, vocational guidance, occupational guidance, guidance for populations with special needs, disadvantaged groups: social, economical and education (over achievers and under achievers), women exploitation at home and work, social guidance, Senior citizens: emotional, social, and physical problems, vocational guidance, moral guidance, and health guidance. Health psychologist must experience in the conducting clinical interviews and behavioral assessment because psychological factors can affect directly health. Similarly, sports psychologist must trained in various mental strategies, such as visualization, self-talk and relaxation techniques can help athletes overcome obstacles and achieve their full potential. Cope with the pressures of competition. Political psychologist must train to new techniques to understand the human mind, social identity, political attitudes, political efficacy, social attitude and ideology of the voters for future election.

The role of organisation psychology and industrial psychology is very important in the current scenarios because today is era of industrialisations in India and Bihar. The industry is beginning day by day so, it is necessary for occupational psychologist must train in the emerging trends like recruitment process of employee, well-being of employee, production, market, sale of product to get more income on goods, good working environment, impact of technology on personnel selection, and efficacy of intervention other approaches for improvement of organisational welfare. Social psychology is also an important branch of psychology. In this time social psychological causes are increasing day by day. Hence, deep knowledge of all the above emerging trends of psychology and others applied understanding of psychological knowledge will be also fruitful for their future, which ultimately will be future of India. For, that purpose organising training programmes, workshops, seminars, conferences in the area of applied psychology involving other branches of psychology would be fruitful. level in every college, organise capacity building programmes in the area of psychology for students, businessman, school teachers, parents, and community. Psychologist of Bihar is lacking of awareness and guidance all these branches of psychology and its applied aspects.
